What will the course cover?

Our training in Health and Social Care will help not only give you the basic understanding of what is required within the sector, but also develop the personal skills and attributes that ensure you are able to deliver a high level of service at all times. You will learn key topics required in the sector including:

- Types of service provisions: identify different types of services and different service users, different job roles within H&SC and career progression.
- Principles and Values in care: understanding principles and values that underpin guidance and standards, valuing service users as individuals, confidentiality and promoting respect.
- Understanding Safeguarding: what does safeguarding mean? Understanding terms, identifying signs of abuse and what actions need to be taken.
- Person Centred Care: defining person centred care, identifying an individual's needs and circumstances and providing person centred care.
- Mental Health: understand factors affecting mental health, benefits of effective communication and treatment.
- Dementia Awareness: understand what dementia is and how to care for someone with dementia.

What qualifications will I receive?

At the end of the course, upon satisfactory completion, all learners will gain up to two qualifications accredited through City and Guilds:

- Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to Health, Social Care and Children's and Young People's Settings
- Level 1 Certificate in Employability

This course is delivered over a 3-4 week programme of learning*

How is the qualification assessed?

The qualification will be assessed through a portfolio of evidence which consists of a structured workbook and a range of practical activities that the learner will complete as part of the course with support provided from a qualified tutor.
