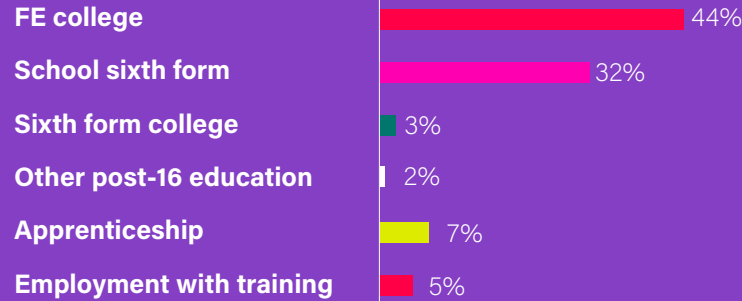

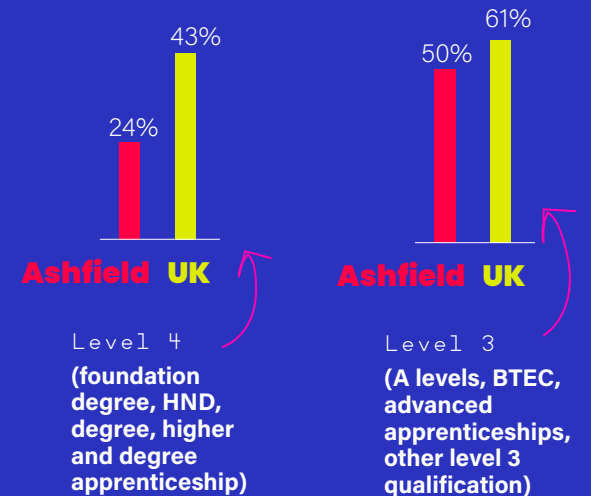

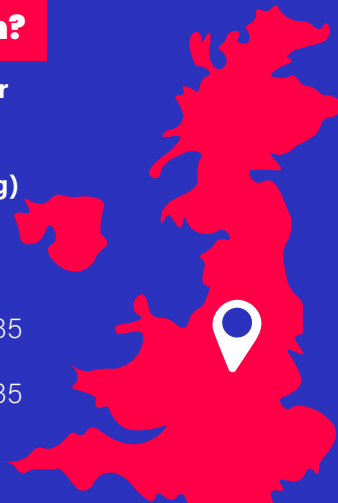
The higher the qualifications you have, the more jobs you'll be able to apply for. Here's how the qualifications levels in Ashfield compare with the UK average:

Proud of Ashfield

- The world's first vertical take-off and landing in a plane took place at the Rolls Royce test centre in Hucknall in 1953.
- King's Mill Hospital is one of Nottinghamshire's largest employers but did you know it started out as an American Army Hospital during the Second World War?
- Ada Lovelace, English mathematician and the world's first known computer programmer, is buried in Hucknall with her father, Lord Byron of Newstead Abbey.
- Kirkby has one of just three gold post boxes in the East Midlands celebrating gold medal winners at the 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Ollie Hynd from Kirkby won swimming gold twice again at the Paralympics in 2016; his brother, Sam, is also a gold Paralympic medallist!
