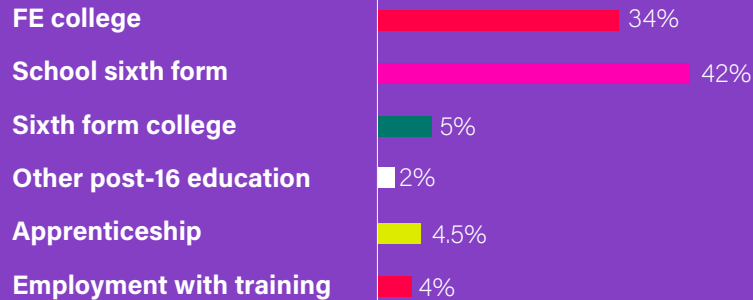

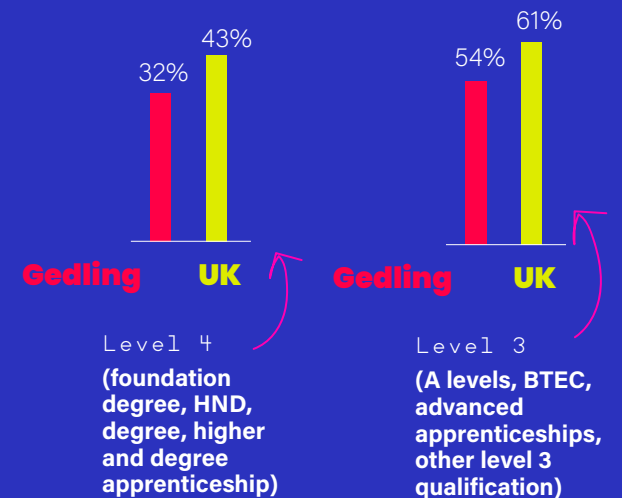

- Did you know, Gedling Country Park is built on 92 year's-worth of coal waste from when it was a former coal pit? Today, an area of the park is home to 22,000 solar panels which generate enough electricity each year to power around 1,500 homes.
