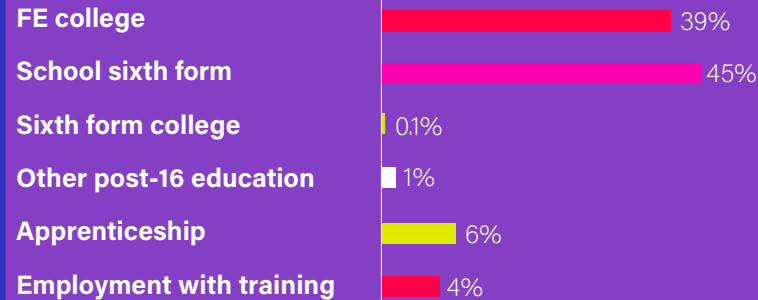

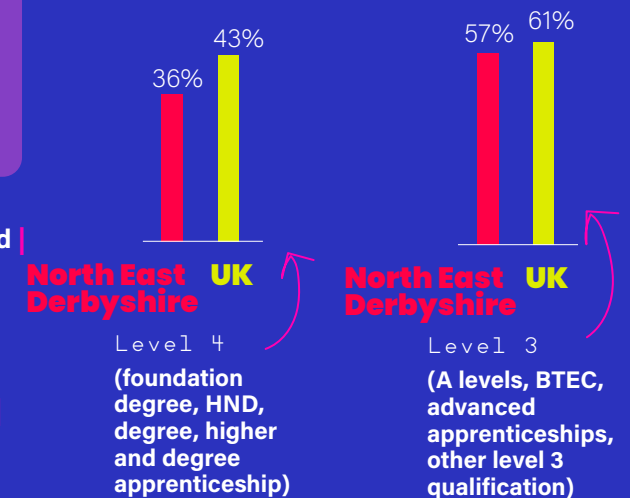

- Henry Boot started his construction company as a sole trader way back in 1886. Now a leading construction company in the UK, the family business built Pinewood Film Studios and supplied and laid the trackwork for the Hong Kong Mass Transit Railway System.
- The world's first football club, Sheffield FC, plays in Dronfield. It's one of only two clubs in the world to be awarded the FIFA Centennial Order of Merit for integrity, respect and community (the other is Real Madrid).
